B. PLACE 32 UNITS OF DESICCANT INTO CONTAINER DESICCANT BASKET.

C. THE ITEM IS THE SHIPPING CONTAINER.

D. (1) THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION SHALL BE MARKED ON THE CONTAINER DATA PLATE FOR ALL CONTAINERS GOING INTO U.S. ARMY DEPOT STOCK:

- (a) CONTAINER SPECIFICATION
- (b) CONTAINER CONTRACT NUMBER
- (c) CONTAINER NATIONAL STOCK NUMBER

(2) ALL THE DATA PLATE INFORMATION WILL BE MARKED ON THE CONTAINER DATA PLATE FOR CONTAINERS GOING TO A TRANSFER CONTRACTOR, TO CONTAINERIZE TRANSFERS. CONTRACTING OFFICER WILL PROVIDE CONTAINER CONTRACTOR WITH THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR THE DATA PLATE:

- (a) TRANSFER MODEL NUMBER
- (b) TRANSFER NATIONAL STOCK NUMBER
- (c) CONTAINER WITH TRANSFER NATIONAL STOCK NUMBER

(3) SPECIAL MARKINGS SHALL BE APPLIED AS FOLLOWS:

- (a) "CARC" SHALL BE MARKED WITH PAINT CONFORMING TO MIL-C-46168 OR MIL-C-53039, COLOR BLACK, IN 1 INCH LETTERS IN AN AREA AS NEAR AS PRACTICAL TO THE NAMEPLATE.
- (b) "REUSABLE CONTAINER: DO NOT DESTROY" SHALL BE MARKED WITH PAINT CONFORMING TO MIL-C-46168 OR MIL-C-53039, COLOR BLACK IN 1/2" HIGH LETTERS IN AN AREA ON THE LOWER CONTAINER SECTION ON THE SAME END AS THE NAME PLATE.
