D. (1) THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION SHALL BE MARKED ON THE CONTAINER DATA PLATE FOR ALL CONTAINERS GOING INTO DEPOT STOCK:
 (a) CONTAINER SPECIFICATION
 (b) CONTAINER CONTRACT NUMBER
 (c) CONTAINER NATIONAL STOCK NUMBER

(2) ALL THE DATA PLATE INFORMATION WILL BE MARKED ON THE CONTAINER DATA PLATE FOR THOSE CONTAINERS GOING TO AN ENGINE CONTRACTOR TO CONTAINERIZE ENGINES. CONTRACTING OFFICER WILL PROVIDE CONTAINER CONTRACTOR WITH THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR THE DATA PLATE:
 (a) ENGINE MODEL NUMBER
 (b) ENGINE NATIONAL STOCK NUMBER
 (c) ENGINE WITH CONTAINER NATIONAL STOCK NUMBER

(3) SPECIAL MARKING SHALL BE APPLIED AS FOLLOWS:
 (a) "CARC" SHALL BE MARKED WITH MIL-C-46168 OR MIL-C-53039 COLOR BLACK, IN 1 IN LETTERS IN AN AREA NEAR THE NAME PLATE.
 (b) "REUSABLE CONTAINER: DO NOT DESTROY" SHALL BE MARKED WITH MIL-C-46168 OR MIL-C-53039 COLOR BLACK, IN ½ IN LETTERS IN AN AREA ON THE LOWER CONTAINER SECTION ON THE SAME END AS THE NAME PLATE.
